The San Juan Islands may be remote, but patients no longer have to expect restricted access to services in San Juan county. Advances in

technology allow PeaceHealth Peace Island Medical Center to provide psychiatric services for our patients right here on the island.

Video conferencing equipment at PeaceHealth Peace Island allows us to directly link with board-certified psychiatrists at a distance. This system allows patients to connect in real time with behavioral health specialists during predetermined appointment times.

How do I get a referral for telepsychiatry?

Patients who are interested in receiving behavioral health services through the telepsychiatry program should first connect with their primary care provider. Once it is determined that the patient would benefit from the specialty services of a psychiatrist, an appointment will be scheduled.
